



YOUNG APEXIAN OF THE YEAR **GRANT SCHEME**

BACKGROUND

The Apex Foundation offers a grant of \$1000 to each yearly winner of the *Young Apexian of the Year* in each State. The grant is to be made from the Apex Foundation Destiny Youth Trust as is designed to support a local youth charity/activity in the community of the Young Apexian of the Year.

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

- A written application detailing the activities of the proposed recipient must be submitted to the Board of the Apex Foundation for approval
- The proposed recipient must be an organisation in the local community of the Young Apexian & works or supports youth in that community. The recipient organisation must supply an Australian Business Number (ABN) either of their organisation or their parent organisation.
- Approved grants are made direct by the Apex Foundation Destiny Youth Trust. Winners must claim their \$1000 prize by 30 June following receipt of their award.
- The presentation must be fully publicised in the local community using all forms of media. Apex Australia will be the name promoted in all publicity.
- Every effort should be made to have at least one of the State President and District Governor in attendance at the presentation.
- Co-ordination and liaison for the application will be with the State President and the Apex Foundation Director responsible for the Destiny Youth Trust
