Hamilton Downs Youth Camp (NT)

Hamilton Downs Youth Camp in NT is a non-profit facility that caters for youth and mature age groups. Through this facility the participants gain basic camping, hiking and sporting skills. Originally established by the Alice Springs Apex Club in 1972, this facility is run by a community based voluntary management committee. In conjunction with renovation work of the complex, \$2,000 was granted for the replacement of woven shade material was needed for an outdoor meeting and activities area.



Hervey Bay Apex Club (QLD)

A local kindergarten and preschool had to remove trees that were causing problems, but in doing so also removed a lot of shade. \$2,000 was granted towards the cost of tree removal and erection of a new shade sail.

Biloela Apex Club (QLD)

Initiated by a young student from Biloela State High School, Hannah Rodda, this musical project involves students from 5 years old to 14 years old. A grant of \$1,000 assists bringing this community together for a wonderful musical performance by local students.

Wodonga Apex Club (VIC)

To assist Wodonga Apex Club with the construction of the new Club facility, a grant of \$3,000 was provided from the General Trust.
